On 09-06-2022, students of undergraduate, post-graduate and doctoral degree programmes were taken to Upper Sindh Hydel Project-II, Kangan to understand the deleterious effects that hydel power projects have on fish populations. An Intra-faculty painting competition themed “Dams and Fish Migrations” was conducted on 10-06-2022 at Faculty of Fisheries, Rangil in which more than 20 students of the faculty participated.
